

Operating Fund Contributions	\$120,450	\$121,993
Operating Fund Expenses	\$80,240	\$82,456

(Contributions fluctuate during various times of the year, while expenses are mostly level from month to month. March results will be available the first week in April.)

Saint James Fund Balances:

Operating Account \$42,318

Capital (Building Mortgage) \$117,082 (Monthly Mortgage payment \$10,273)

Designated Funds (8 Funds) \$112,181 (Largest is Reserve Fund \$78,150)

Youth Fund \$11,161 Endowment Fund (with ELCA) \$44,896

Included in the Designated Funds is the Tanzania Roof Project which has raised well over \$10,000.

The Treasurer meets multiple times each month to review bills and sign checks and the Council reviews the income and expenses each month at their Council Meeting. If you have any questions, please contact me.
